Project Levy

Participation by all athletes in the 2013 Cyclo-cross World Championships is entirely self-funded and they may be required to contribute to the costs of support staff. Athletes' personal sponsors may benefit from advertising space on their uniforms, within the constraints imposed by the UCI regulations.

Cycling Canada has asked their existing support staff to attend the Cyclo-Cross World Championships on a volunteer basis. In addition Cycling Canada has sought out industry partnership in order to provide world-class support while attempting to limit the costs incurred by the riders.

The project charge-back has been estimated to be \$800-\$1000 dollars depending on the final amount of athletes and staff who attend.
